

Permitted/Restricted Item List

We suggest that participants bring enough clothes to last them for the 14 days with use of the laundry services. We also recommend folks bring comfier clothing and to include a variety of warmer and cooler clothing as temperatures can fluctuate while on the unit. It is recommended to bring sandals for the showers and hygiene products, however the unit does have free hygiene products available for anyone to use while on the unit. It is also recommended, but not required, to bring items to help pass the time on the unit, such as art and crafts items, puzzle books, or other similar non-electronic items.

Below is a list of items permitted and restricted on the unit. Any items with an * are allowed to be used by participants, but not allowed to be held in participants rooms full time. Any items in a large tube or bottle, such as hygiene products, must be put into a small cup before giving that item to a participant.
